2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,

"Church" means the Pentecostal Church of God of NY in Belize Inc; "Corporation" means the corporation of Church by the name "Pentecostal

Church of God of NY in Belize Inc.," constituted under section 3 of this "property" means property of every description, real or personal, moveable or immovable.

3. The Pentecostal Church of God of NY in Belize Inc., is hereby constituted under a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal which may from time to time be altered, and it may by its corporate name sue or be sued, plead or be impleaded in all courts of law.

4. The President of the Church for the time being and his successors in office shall form the Committee of Management of the Church which shall be responsible for administering the affairs of the Church.

5. Any deed or other instrument, or any interest therein shall be deemed to be fully executed if there is affixed to that deed or other instrument the seal of the Church and the signatures of any two officers of the Committee of Management of the Church duly authorized for the purpose.

6. The Church shall exercise all of the powers and perform all the functions and duties directed and empowered by the Chairman of the Church and its Committee of Management.
