CHAPTER 339

Definition of Time

[11th March, 1947]

2. The Standard Time to be observed throughout Belize for all purposes

whatever, save as hereinafter provided, shall be the mean time of Longitude ninety degrees West, which is seven minutes, seventeen seconds and

3. The Minister responsible for Home Affairs may from time to time by Order published in the *Gazette* prescribe that the local time in Belize shall vary from Standard Time as fixed in section 2 of this Act, by such lengths

Council, Order, regulation rule, by-law, deed, notice or other document whatever, unless it is otherwise specifically stated, the time referred to shall be deemed to be the time fixed by section 2 of this Act or such other time as the Minister responsible for Home Affairs may under section 3
